

1. Experts' consultation on women centred Maternal Health care in Mumbai

CommonHealth conducted a study aimed at exploring women's perspectives on women-centered maternal health care with support from its grassroots partners in nine locations across India. In the second phase of this initiative, it brought together experts in the field to deliberate on grassroots women's experiences, expectations, and perspectives from an intersectional and equity lens. The consultation was held in Mumbai on March 15-16th, 2024, and included experts from medicine, public health, sexual and reproductive health, and community-level practitioners. CommonHealth aims to document these experts' inputs to build a technically sound, yet women-centered, framework for maternal health care. An expected outcome of this dialogue was to achieve a consensus position on Women-Centered Maternal Health Care and to develop a strategy for disseminating and socializing this position.
